

Scheme of 'Post-Matric Scholarship' for Students belonging to the Minority Communities

About

The objective of the scheme is to award scholarships to meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of minority community so as to provide them better opportunities for higher education, increase their rate of attainment in higher education and enhance their employability.

Benefits

Financial Assistance that will be provided for admission & course/tuition fee and maintenance is given below with a maximum amount against each item:

- Admission and tuition fee for classes XI and XII for Hosteller & Day Scholar: Rs. 7,000 p.a.
- Admission and course/tuition fee for technical and vocational courses of XI and XII level for Hosteller & Day Scholar: Rs. 10,000 p.a.
- Admission and tuition fee for under-graduate, post graduate: Rs. 3,000 p.a.

Maintenance allowance for 10 months only in academic year:

- Classes XI and XII including technical and vocational courses of this level for Hosteller & Day Scholar: Rs. 380 p.m. &Rs. 230 p.m. respectively
- Courses other than technical and professional courses at under-graduate and post-graduate level for Hosteller and Day Scholar: Rs. 570 p.m. &Rs 300 p.m. respectively
- M.Phil and Ph.D for Hosteller and Day Scholar: Rs. 1200 p.m. &Rs. 550 p.m.

Eligibility

Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardian from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh.

How to Apply
